MEET OUR NEW LABS!

<u>AREL</u> — The objectives of Action for Refugee Life, located in the Kakuma Refugee camp, in Kenya, are to provide training for those who lack skills, and facilitate their access to job opportunities. They aim to give them power to become self reliant participants in a life that is both economically and socially rewarding.



<u>BARACO FOUNDATION</u> — Lack of vocational training and skill development centers in Mbozi, Tanzania, leaves young people no possible way to earn a living wage. The lab will provide training in computer skills, coding, web and graphic design, and Microsoft Office, to equip young people, especially girls, with skills necessary to earn self-sufficient wages. They hope to break the struggles of young girls who have no choice but to marry as teens, depriving them of socio-economic opportunities and living a life of poverty.



<u>EHPO</u> — The mission of Empowerment and Health Promotion Organization (EHPO) is to strengthen the economic and social independence of vulnerable groups in their local community by focusing on empowering girls, young women and boys through enhancement of economic independence and personal wellbeing through computer literacy.



<u>KAKUMA BEE SOCIAL</u> — By providing access to technology and training, Kakuma Bee Social Enterprise, located in Kakuma Refugee Camp, Kenya, hopes to empower marginalized individuals with valuable job skills to enhance their employment prospects, self-sufficiency and personal development.

SARDI — Based in Thika, Kenya, SARDI's (Sustainable Agriculture and Rural Development Initiative) goal is to empower farmers and communities who are computer illiterate by equipping them with computer skills thus enabling them to find work that helps to support their families.

TRANSFORMERS CONNECT — Their project plans to support vulnerable and disabled girls in Mathare slums, in Nairobi, Kenya, by teaching them computer programming skills. They plan on training more women, youth, and persons living with disabilities to learn how to code and create the next software developers from the heart of Mathare.



<u>UPENDO</u> — Upendo's vision is to eradicate poverty through education and skills training to improve the lives of people in Kawangware slums, in Nairobi, Kenya. Their mission is to nurture and empower women and young girls suffering from mental illness and gender based violence in the community.
